No correspondence had been received and there was not much to report money wise. The paperwork for the Six Counties had come to just over £26 and the meeting felt that this was a small sum to pay for such a professional looking programme.

## League Secretary's report

The forthcoming season had no rule changes and results sheets were distributed.

As decided at the AGM the number of mats on which games would be played were as follows:Suffolk, Norfolk and Herts - 4 mats, Essex - still negotiating, Beds and Cambs - unknown.
